**Test Results from Last Week and Next Steps**

It is with great relief that we share that last week's emergency testing results were all negative! This allows us to reopen most of The Harbors for visitors, shared dining and activities. Floors that can reopen are all of assisted living memory support (floor 7), skilled nursing (floors 8 and 9) and most of assisted living (floors 11 and 12 only).

The exception to the reopening of The Harbors is the 10<sup>th</sup> floor of The Harbors which is the floor where the positive case was discovered last week. The presence of a positive case requires the floor to be in quarantine for a two-week period. It also means that the residents of the 10<sup>th</sup> floor as asked to remain on the 10<sup>th</sup> floor during this time. Assuming there are no new positive cases in our community, the 10<sup>th</sup> floor of The Harbors will reopen fully in about a week.

**Testing Schedule for Staff and Harbors' Residents**

Even with the favorable results from last week's emergency testing, we must continue with more frequent testing for all staff (including private caregivers) and all Harbors' residents. Testing for the next few days will follow the schedule below.

If you are on staff or if you are a private caregiver, it is your responsible to secure testing for each of the below intervals. The Admiral is pleased to make testing available to you here at the times and dates listed below. If you cannot make it into The Admiral for one or more of these days, you can utilize any of the free testing resources readily available these days or secure a test at your other employer. If you do not test here, you will be responsible for timely sharing of official test results with Mark Dubovick by email at [mdubovick@admiral.kendal.org](mailto:mdubovick@admiral.kendal.org).

**Test Schedule:**

- Sunday, May 2 or Monday, May 3 (10 am to 12 pm, 2 pm to 4:30 pm or overnight by the 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> floor nurse)
- Wednesday, May 5 (10 am to 12 pm, 2 pm to 4:30 pm or overnight by 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> floor nurse) or Thursday, May 6 (10 am to 1 pm)
- Note: Sunday, May 9 will have no testing this week
- Monday, May 10 (starts the night before only after 6 am by 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> floor nurse, 10 am to 12 pm or 2 pm to 4:30 pm) or Tuesday, May 11 (10 am to 1 pm)

All testing will happen in the 6<sup>th</sup> floor conference room unless it is the overnight testing happening by the nurse on the 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> floor.

Regular testing times/dates expected to resume the week of Sunday, May 16 but this will depend on the results of the above tests.
