Happy Vaccination Week!

For nearly 170 of us, Wednesday's vaccination clinic will include the second and final dose of the Moderna vaccine. A few weeks from that second dose, those who received it will have the greatest level of protection against the COVID virus possible - about 95% efficacy based on clinical trials. For a couple hundred more people, Wednesday's vaccination clinic will be the first step toward protection against the COVID virus.

It could be mid-to-late summer before younger and healthier members of the populations receive the vaccine so please do not miss this opportunity for early access! Based on what we know today, Wednesday's clinic could be your last opportunity to receive the first dose (and, on February 24, the second dose) of the vaccine at work and ahead of the general public. Coming Soon: Some Re-opening in IL

Beginning Monday, February 1 we will see some activities return to the Independent Living portion of the community. Specifically, we will return to in-person options for exercise classes, programming, card/game playing and meetings. In all cases involving in-person gatherings and events, there is a limit of 10 people or less, masks and distancing will be required. Sign-ups are required for exercise and attending programs using the books provided outside The Gathering Room. Speakers will be allowed in The Gathering Room and will be required to be symptom checked in the main lobby at the start of their visit and will be asked to wear a mask anytime they are within 6 feet of another person.

The changes outlined above only apply to IL residents and IL spaces at this time. The licensed areas of the community – all levels of living in The Harbors – must be reopened in conformance with local, state and federal guidance and regulations. For this reason, we should expect that The Harbors will reopen differently than IL, likely to be more conservative in its approach and timing. We will share more about The Harbors as soon as we have more to share.
